Supply List for a 27" x 36" wall hanging

If you plan to work with prints and solids instead of strip sets:

- 20 - 30 ½ yards

If you plan to work with strip sets, first review "[Into the Strata-sphere](#)" for guidance on fabric selection and constructing your strip sets. Construction of your strip sets should be completed before class in order to get the most out of class time:

- 1-1½ yds of focus fabric
- ¼ - ⅓ yd each of 17-20 different fabrics that coordinate with your focus fabric

IT IS INCREDIBLY IMPORTANT TO HEAVILY SPRAY STARCH AND PRESS YOUR FABRIC BEFORE CLASS. PRESS - DON'T IRON. YOU ARE STABILIZING THE FABRIC BEFORE CUTTING.

- Strips 'n Curves Basic + Basic Set II template sets. If you already own one or both template sets, bring them! Both sets will be available for purchase in class for \$37.95+tax each or \$70+tax for the two sets.
- Sewing machine in good working order – don't forget your manual, electric cord, and pedal!
- If you have a knee lift bring it - it's very helpful
- ¼" foot is a must (or your favorite way to assure ¼" seams)
- Basic sewing supplies (scissors, seam ripper, pins, extra machine needles, etc.)
- Fine pins
- Glue pen with a few refills
- Neutral thread and several that coordinate with your fabric choices
- Extra bobbin(s)
- 28mm rotary cutter with new blade – the smaller size cuts curves sooooo much better than a 45mm
- Medium size cutting mat. If you have a rotating mat, bring that one. It makes cutting curves much easier.
- 6"x12" and 6"x18" rulers
- Fine point Sharpie marker
- Heat resistant** template plastic (sheets of Dritz heat resistant template plastic will be available in class for \$4+tax)
- Iron and ironing surface if there is sufficient space and workshop sponsor permits individual irons
- Foam core or flannel covered board to use as a design wall

Helpful but not required

- Value finder/viewer, if you have one
- Louisa Smith's book "Strips and Curves: A New Spin on Strip Piecing," if you already own it
